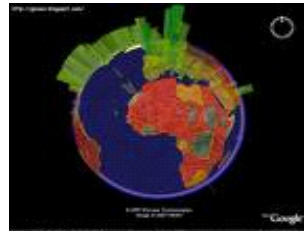

SENSEX SLIPS ON RIL RULING

The verdict on RIL-RNRL led to 7.48% fall in the RIL stock. RIL has a weight of 15.97% in the Sensex. The price of RNRL rose 24.11%. Consequently, the oil and gas index was the biggest loser and slid by 4.51%. Metal and consumer goods followed by slipping 3.86% and 3.66%, respectively.
