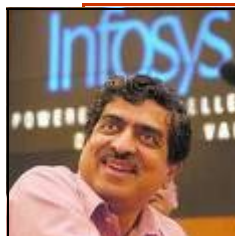

Infosys Co- Chairman Nandan Nilekani appointed as Chairman of the Unique Identification Database Authority of India

Nilekani has stepped down from the Infosys Board. He is handpicked by the Prime Minister to head an ambitious project to provide every citizen a unique national ID by 2011. The system of unique national ID will be similar to the social security number in US. Nilekani, whose new position carries the rank of cabinet minister, will work with India's apex planning agency— the Planning Commission— on the project which will cover around 1.2 billion people—the largest such project in the world. Although he has resigned from the Board of Directors of Infosys, he still continues to be a main shareholder in the company.
